Game Day Box Office Hours

The box office will open one hour before the following events; men's and women's basketball, men's and women's soccer, volleyball and lacrosse.

Friday Hockey games the box office will remain open until the second intermission. Saturday hockey the west box office will open at 3pm and remain open until the second intermission.

Week Day Walk Up and Will Call

The ticket window at the West Box Office is open from **9am to 5pm Monday-Friday**. A photo ID must be presented by the ticket purchaser to pick up will call (pre-purchased) tickets.

Delivery Methods

You can choose to receive your tickets by Mail, Print At Home, Will Call or via Mobile Delivery

- **Mail** - You should receive your single game tickets in 5-7 business days.
- **Print At Home Tickets** - Purchase your tickets online and you can print your tickets immediately after you purchase them. Just select 'Print at Home' as your delivery option and your tickets will be e-mailed to you after you have completed your purchase. Each ticket must be printed on the full 8.5 x 11 piece of paper.

- **Mobile Ticket Delivery** - will allow patrons entrance into the arena via their mobile device instead of a paper ticket. Make sure to have your ticket pulled up on your phone upon arrival.
- **Will Call**- located in the West Ticket Office Monday-Friday from 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. For home hockey games on Saturdays, Will Call is open from 3:00 p.m. **YOU MUST HAVE A PHOTO ID TO PICK-UP YOUR TICKETS. PLEASE HAVE IT READY WHEN YOU ARRIVE AT WILL CALL.**

Lost Ticket/Reprint Policy

Any tickets that are lost or forgotten and need to be reprinted must be requested through the Athletic Ticket Office. Only the person whose name is on the account can request replacement. There is a \$5 per ticket fee to reprint event tickets.

Accessible Seating

We do offer ADA seating at our venues. Tickets are sold in pairs in ADA locations, one (1) for the person in need of assistance and one (1) for a companion. Seating is limited and it is sold on a first come, first served basis. It is possible to exchange for ADA if something as occurred that precludes you from accessing the location of the seats. You will need to contact our main ticket office in order to purchase/exchange these seats 303.871.4625.

POST SEASON TICKET POLICY

TRAVELLING TO NCAA POST-SEASON

When traveling for NCAA post-season, Denver Athletics is allocated a certain amount of tickets for distribution. After the team ticketing needs, order for distribution (location and allotment) is as follows:

1. Current donors to Athletics Excellence Fund or Sport participating in post-season
 - a. RED VEST, MILE HIGH: Up to six tickets, may request additional
 - b. VARSITY, PIONEER: Up to four tickets, may request additional
 - c. VICTORY BELL, GO FOR 32: May request up to four
2. Current Season Ticket Holders: May request up to four
3. General Public: May request up to four

HOSTING NCAA POST-SEASON

When hosting NCAA post-season, Denver Athletics will allocate distribution of tickets, after the team and NCAA ticketing needs, in the following order:

1. Current Season Ticket Holders: Up to the number of seats held for the year. May request additional tickets beyond number of seats held for the year.
1. Current donors to Pioneer Movement (Athletics Excellence or sport participating in post-season)
 - a. RED VEST: Up to eight tickets, may request additional
 - b. MILE HIGH: Up to six tickets, may request additional
 - c. VARSITY, PIONEER: Up to four tickets, may request additional
 - d. VICTORY BELL, GO FOR 32: Up to two tickets, may request additional
